### **Minimum Scholarship Requirements: You must ....**

- **Be a member or have an immediate family relative that is a member of Telesis Community Credit Union**
- **Be completing your senior year in a high school**
- **Be in good standing with your school and not on disciplinary or academic probation**
- **Have an academic GPA of 2.0 or greater and plan to continue your education**
- **Have an outstanding record of community service**
- **Fully complete the attached application**

### **Applicants will be judged on the following:**

- **Community Service measured in quantity, quality and results. Community service is for activities that originate outside of school to benefit the community.**
- **Essays will be judged for:**
  - **Clarity of Expression – Is the essay understandable?**
  - **Content – Did the essay answer the question?**
  - **Originality – Is there original thought?**

### **Awards**

Scholarship winners will be notified by their school. Scholarships may be presented at your school's senior award ceremony (if possible) or other arrangements will be made.

**A complete application form, essay questions and resume of community service, must be delivered to a Telesis Community Credit Union branch location no later than APRIL 15, 2010. You may also submit by mail to:**
